This event is a state campaign activity. For NSW State Campaigns, there are strict laws regarding who can pay and how much can be paid for fundraising events or as donations in any financial year. It varies for state, local government and federal campaigns.

WHO CAN PAY for state campaigns/donations/fundraising events:

Individuals must be on an Australian electoral roll . Organisations must have an ACN (Australian Company Number) or ABN (Australian Business Number)

WHO CAN'T PAY – prohibited donors:

In NSW certain industries are considered “prohibited donors” and we are unable to accept payments from them for state campaigns. Prohibited donors are property developers, tobacco industry business entity or a for-profit liquor or gambling business. Prohibited donors also include close associates. A company director or company officer and their spouses and a person whose voting power is greater than 20% are considered close associates.

Prohibited donors apply to both state campaign payments and local government campaign payments.

HOW MUCH can you donate/pay to attend a fundraising event(s):

There is a maximum of \$6,100 and a requirement to declare over \$1,000 in the financial year for contributions to the NSW state campaign.

A limit of \$6,100 for the financial year applies for total payments to the Liberal Party in NSW for the state campaign (there are separate rules for amounts donated to the NSW Liberal Party for Federal or Local Government Campaigns). The limit applies to both individuals and companies. Contributions over \$1,000 in a financial year must be disclosed to the Election Funding Authority (NSW), in accordance with the Election Funding Expenditure and Disclosure Act 1981. A political donation includes a contribution or entry fee or annual or other subscription. Penalties apply for failing to lodge a declaration.
